

PTA Founders Day program to be held at Dover Monday

Monday night Dover PTA will celebrate the 75th anniversary of the organization of the National Congress of PTA, which took place Feb. 17, 1897, in Washington, D.C.

The Founders Day program, scheduled to begin at 8 in Park Elementary School, will feature Robert Barnaby, cost analyst in the accounting department at Republic Steel Corp. Central Alloy District, as guest speaker.

"Let's Examine the News" is the topic chosen by Barnaby, a graduate of Indiana State University in Indiana, Pa., and a member of the National Association of Accountants and the Reserve Officers' Assn.
