## Marion Harding Favored to Win AAA Crown; Chanel and Dayton Jefferson in AA Dogfight

COLUMBUS — Traditionally teams with great sprinters and relays are the ones to win state track and field championships. That's why this year's 76th boys and ninth girls' state meet will be another "Speed Show" when survivors from last week's regionals gather to decide who is best in Ohio Stadium Friday and Saturday.

The record-breaking that has characterized recent state meets will continue this weekend. A check of season-long performances and last week's regional reports indicate that nine state meet records have been bettered and another 29 marks will be threatened in A, AA and AAA. The biggest onslaught is expected in AAA boys where six records are possible and 10 by girls.

Last year Cleveland Heights and John Adams shared the AAA crown, while Dayton Roth won in AA and Dayton Christian in A. Columbus Mifflin took the AAA girls title, while Columbus East won in AA and Minster in Class A.

How does the team races stack up this season?

In boys AAA, Marion Harding gets the edge over Dayton Dunbar, Columbus West, Dayton Meadowdale, John Adams, Akron Buchtel and Massillon Washington. Yes, the football-famed Massillon Tigers are strong in track, too. They qualified seven plus the 400 relay, but some are asking if they are for real. Those who saw Massillon in the Amherst Regional feel they should finish high this weekend.

Marion has to do it with two super individuals in Robert Pittman in the highs (14.3) and lows (36.8) and Zorba Ross in the 400 (47.8), 200

(21.9) and long jump (23.1). Marion's 3:16.8 is the second-fastest 1600 relay time in the state behind John Adams' 3:16.6, and Marion followers say they will beat Adams at the state.

In Class AA, Dayton Jefferson and Bedford Chanel will fight it out. Our computer says it could be a high-scoring affair, 50-49, and you take your choice. Dayton Chaminade-Julienne, with sprinter Trey Coleman; Chagrin Falls and Circleville are other contenders.

In Class A, Columbus Wehrle is favored here, but Allen East is a big threat. Defending champion Dayton Christian and Columbus Academy will be challengers.

Columbus Mifflin should repeat in AAA girls, but Trotwood Madison looms strong with LaVonna Martin entered in four events — the low hurdles (13.95 in 100 (12.84), 200 (25.46) and 400 (53.41). Trotwood also has Janice Talley in the high jump and long jump and could win it all.

Columbus East must fight off Sunbury Big Walnut in what should be a two-team battle in AA. Minster is shooting for its seventh title in eight years and rates the edge over Zanesville Rosecrans.

Minster has three of the four leading Class A relay times in the state, 50.2 in the 400, 4:07.0 in the 1,600 and 9:56.2 in the 3,200. Susan Nash is Rosecrans' ace. She will be trying for a triple in the 100, 400 and 800.

The unofficial individual and team qualifiers are on pages 4-5-6-7. The performances listed are marks made in last weekend's regionals.



Charles E. Martin of Cleveland will be head starter for the second year in a row at the state meet. He has been officiating 21 years, seven in the state meet.

# 'Dynamic' Nash Seeks Repeat Victories at State

"She's the most dynamic and competitive athlete I've been associated with," said Coach Dave Bell of Zanesville Rosecrans in describing versatile junior Susan Nash.

Nash won the state Class A 400 and 800-meter titles last year and she'll try for a repeat at this week's championships in Columbus.

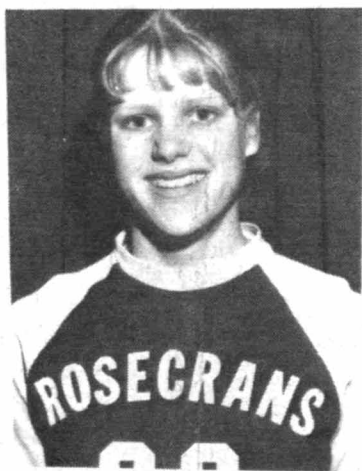
In addition, she'll run on the Rosecrans 1,600-meter relay.

Susan's best times this season are 12.4 in the 100, 56.7 in the 400 and 2:13.1 in the 800. Her 400 and 800 marks are the best in Class 'A' this season.

"Susan is a quality athlete," says Bell. "She played on our state championship basketball team as an outside forward and she was first in the state cross country team race last fall."

"Besides her athletics, Susan is a very nice girl in school. She puts forth 110% all the time in everything she does, and I'm glad we will have her for another year."

Bell said his telephone has been ringing off the hook with college

Rosecrans won the state team crown two years ago and was runner-up to Minster last season.

"I think we have an excellent shot at it," Bell said about regaining the crown. —E.C.

## HOBAN'S REYNOLDS HURTS KNEE IN REGIONAL

Akron Hoban's Harry Reynolds had to be scratched from the 100, 200 and 400 after he injured his knee long jumping at the Brooklyn AA Regional last Wednesday. He spanned 20-3 on his third try when his knee popped.

Reynolds had the fastest AA marks in the 200 (21.4), 400 (47.9) and long jump (22-11 $\frac{3}{4}$ ). He also had a ranking 10.7 in the 100-meter dash.

# St. Ignatius Hurdler Walsh is Peaking at the Right Time

Hurdler Pat Walsh seems to be peaking just at the right time.

After posting two straight 14.0 clockings in the 110-meter highs, the fastest in the state this season, Walsh appears to be on course for his bid at the state title this weekend in Columbus.

"Walsh is technically a very excellent hurdler," said St. Ignatius coach Chuck Kyle. "He's not exactly fast, but he is quick and he takes advantage of his strength."

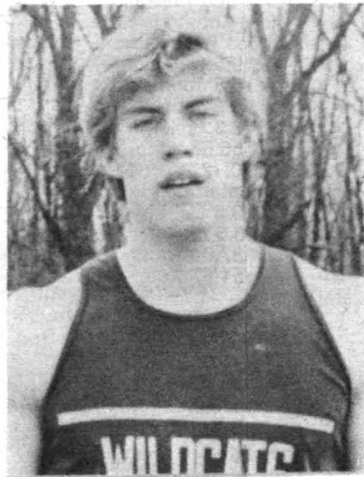
"Each week this season you could see his improvement, and now that he'll be pushed at the state his time should drop even more."

"If he gets that good start he could win it."

Walsh, who will be one of many Ohioans competing in next week's Midwest Meet of Champions in Ft. Wayne, Ind., said a turning point this season came when he won the 55-meter highs in 7.2 seconds at the Cleveland Knights of Columbus meet.

"The best hurdlers from the area were there and it gave me a psychological edge going into the outdoor season," Walsh said.

His only loss was at the Mansfield Relays. He pulled up when he hit a hurdle -- which he rarely does -- and stopped. Otherwise, he has won all his races to date.

Walsh also runs the third leg on St. Ignatius' strong 1,600 relay but hurdling is his first love.

"I concentrated strictly on my technique since I was a sophomore and that helped me a lot," said Walsh, headed for Miami, O., on a track scholarship.

Walsh says his goal is to run a 13.8 and making the finals of the state 110-meter highs.

"Going to Columbus is a satisfying experience," he said. "I don't like being the favorite. I'd prefer to be the underdog." —E.C.

# Schuh Arrives as Sprinter

Donna Schuh, Avon Lake High junior who is the defending AAA long jump champion and a premier sprinter, is not concerned that her long jumping has not been as consistent as last year's.

She won the state in 1982 with a leap of 18-11 $\frac{1}{4}$ . Her best this season is 18-7 $\frac{1}{2}$ , which ranks second in Ohio, but she has emerged as an impressive sprinter and relay runner.

Her dash marks are at the top of the state rankings with 11.9 for the 100, 24.7 in the 200 and she runs a strong anchor on the 1,600-meter relay for the school.

"At the Comet Relays this year we discovered we had a good anchor when Donna ran a 58.0 split," said coach Chuck Hofelich. "Since then she's helped us to a 4:06.2."

Hofelich describes Schuh as a perfectionist. "She's very business-

like and a tremendous worker," he said.

"She's very detailed and she prepares well. She eats all the right foods, gets her rest and does everything right."

Hofelich is not concerned that Schuh's long jump distance has not matched last year's mark.

"She'll do all right at the state," he said. "And she could surprise in the 100 and 200."

The Shoremen also figure to be a contender for the AAA team title.

Donna is a popular student and she's very active in things other than sports. She's a member of the National Honor Society.

In last Saturday's AA Regional finals at Amherst Steele, Schuh equalled her own state-leading time in the 100-meters at 11.9 and she also qualified in the 200 with a second-place in 24.9.

Schuh spanned 18-0 $\frac{1}{2}$  in the long jump to place third and nail a spot to the state finals. She also helped Avon Lake to a second place in the 1,600-meter relay with 4:02.5.

Mau is better known around the state and midwest for his exploits as a two-miler. He won the AAA 3,200-meter run at last year's state meet and he's a state cross country champion.

This weekend, Mau will shoot for the 1,600 and 800 titles at the state meet in Columbus.

Unbeaten this outdoor season, Mau tops the state in the 1,600 with 4:13.2. In the 800 he has a 1:55.4. His best 3,200 is 9:20.0.

"I'd like to show people that I'm a good miler," said Mau, the 18-year-old senior who is headed for Northwestern.

Mau has not been tested this season. He usually runs by himself, out in front and has been winning by big margins. His close-

How good a miler is Mau? "Very good. I think good enough to run a 4:08 at the state and he has the speed to run a good 800," Gawne said.

Gawne is impressed with Mau's determination. "He's such a conditioned athlete, but he still works hard. He's an all-around runner," the coach said.

In addition to winning the individual state cross country crown last fall, Mau received international exposure when he was invited to represent the United States on the junior team for the World Cross Country meet.

# Shetler Comes Calling 4th Straight Year

It seems like Tom Shetler of Strasburg Franklin keeps popping up at the state meet finals every year. This weekend will be his fourth straight trip and he hopes it's as rewarding as last year when he won the Class A 3,200-meter run.

Shetler has been coming to Columbus since his freshman year and he likes the experience.

This week he's taking on the added chore of bidding for the 1,600-meter title.

"He's capable of winning both races," said Strasburg coach Cliff Bronson. "In the meets he has run this season, he has done it by himself. There's been very little competition. I don't know what his limit is."

Shetler, who has posted best times this season of 4:17.4 in the 1600 and 9:13.2 in the 3200, has been beaten only once this season.

"That was at the Shadyside Relays and I lost to Steve Taylor of West Virginia, who ran 4:18 and 9:10," Shetler said. But since then he has not lost a race.
